Prayas - The Parent Body

A registered National level Voluntary Organisation, Prayas was established in 1988 by the Founder General Secretary, Mr. Amod K. Kanth as an emergency relief and rehabilitation measure for children who were rendered homeless in a devastating fire in Jahangirpuri, in North-West Delhi.

From a modest start of just 25 children Prayas today undertakes various community development programmes with an outreach to some 50000 children as well as less fortunate women belonging to weaker sections of society surrounding hundreds of slums in and around Delhi and parts of Gujrat, Assam, Bihar and now the Tsunami devastated Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Jan Shikshan Sansthan Prayas (JSSP)

Jan Shikshan Sansthan or Institute of People's Education is a polyvalent Adult Education Programme aimed at improving the Vocational Skills and quality of the life of its beneficiaries. In the year 2000, the Ministry of HRD had sanctioned Jan Shikshan Sansthan formerly known as Shramik Vidya Peeth to various NGOs in the country. Prayas having the distinction in this field and long partnership with Shramik Vidya Peeth was selected by the Ministry of running the Jan Shikshan Sansthan in Delhi. As such JSS Prayas was launched in August, 2000.

Objective

1. To improve the occupational skills and technical knowledge of the neo-literates and the trainees and to raise their efficiency and increase productive ability.
2. To serve as nodal continuing education centres.
3. To organise training and orientation courses for Key Resource Persons, MasterTrainers.
4. To organise equivalency programmes through Open Learning System.
5. To promote national goals such as secularism, national integration, population and development, women's equality, protection and conservation of environment.



Target Group

Youth and women in the age group of 15 - 35 years broadly drawn from weaker sections of the community consisting of SC/St/OBC/ Minorities and the Neo Literates.

Activities & Achievements of JSS Prayas

Vocational Training

Imparting vocational training and skill development based on market survey is the main activity of JSS Prayas. As on date vocational training is being imparted in 40 trades at around 17 centres in Delhi.

Adult Literacy & Life Skill Education

- ★ Life Enrichment Education in collaboration with State Resource Centre Jamia Milia Islamia.
- ★ Accreditation by NIOS for Open Basic Education Programme.
- ★ Collaboration with CII for Non Formal Education in slum clusters of Delhi under Basti Shiksha Pariyojna with the motive of eradicating illiteracy.
- ★ Collaboration with GE - Youth Reach for Life Skill Programme to ensure holistic development of youth.

Self Help Group (SHG) & Women Empowerment

No country can progress without the empowerment of its women folk. It is estimated that women account for half of the world population and 2/3 of the world's poorest people. Poverty in both developed and developing countries has a predominantly female face. Realising this, JSS Prayas has promoted SHGs in different parts of Delhi. Besides savings and micro credit activities, these groups serve as a forum for the poor woman to;

1. voice their views
2. interact with one another
3. share their experiences
4. exchange ideas on various issues
5. initiate collective action on wide range of social personal and economic issues



JSS Prayas is at present performing the role of facilitator for their linkages to the bank. JSS Prayas is also providing them technical assistance and support services such as identification of livelihood opportunities, technology upgradation and upgradation of their vocational skills.

Placement Cell

JSS Prayas with a mission to provide job opportunities to its beneficiaries and other residents of slums and resettlement colonies established a placement cell with the help of Bodh Raj Sawhney Memorial Trust and HPS foundation in the year 2002. The placement unit has been in touch with various agencies, organizations & corporates to provide job opportunities to the beneficiaries. HSBC, HPCL, GE, Batra Hospital, Hotel Taj Mansingh, Hotel Ambassador Rotary Blood Bank, Coca-Cola India Ltd. are the main collaborators. Till date around 3500 beneficiaries have been placed
